

SCS

Supervised Consumption Services are federally approved services where people use drugs, are monitored for overdose, and receive medical assistance from trained staff in the event of an emergency.

How do SCS save the health system money?





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Overdose Deaths
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It has been estimated that the **Insite SCS in Vancouver** saves the health system between \$200,000 and \$6,000,000 per year.

7 studies

have examined the cost savings of **different SCS in Vancouver.** All of these studies found evidence of cost savings from the SCS that was studied.



6 studies

have examined the cost savings of **prospective** facilities in cities across Canada. All of these studies recommended implementing a minimum of $2\,SCS$ in the studied city.



Studies from other jurisdictions also estimate that SCS save money overall.
